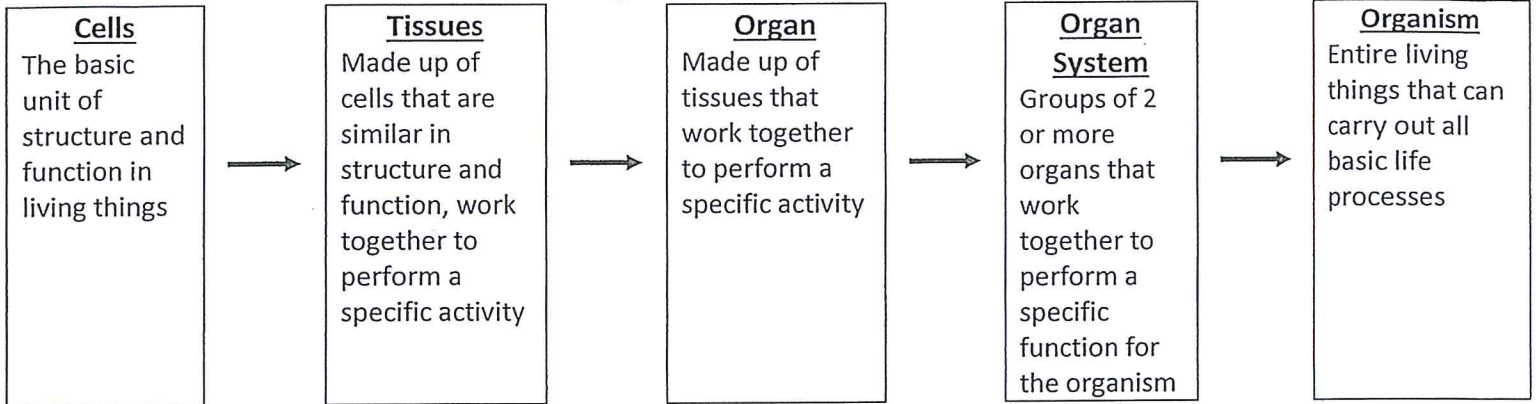


Science Starters – Levels of Organization
